

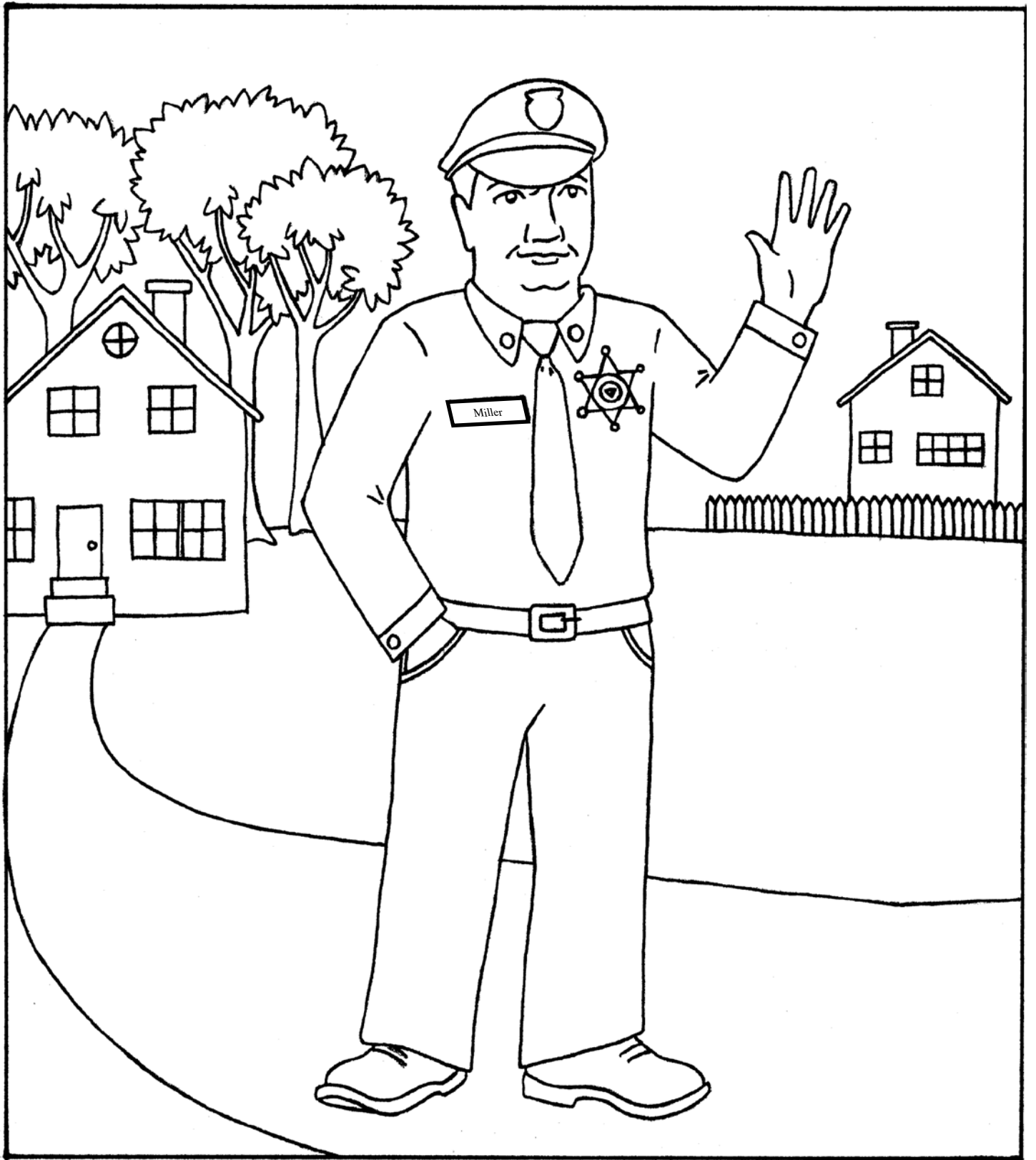

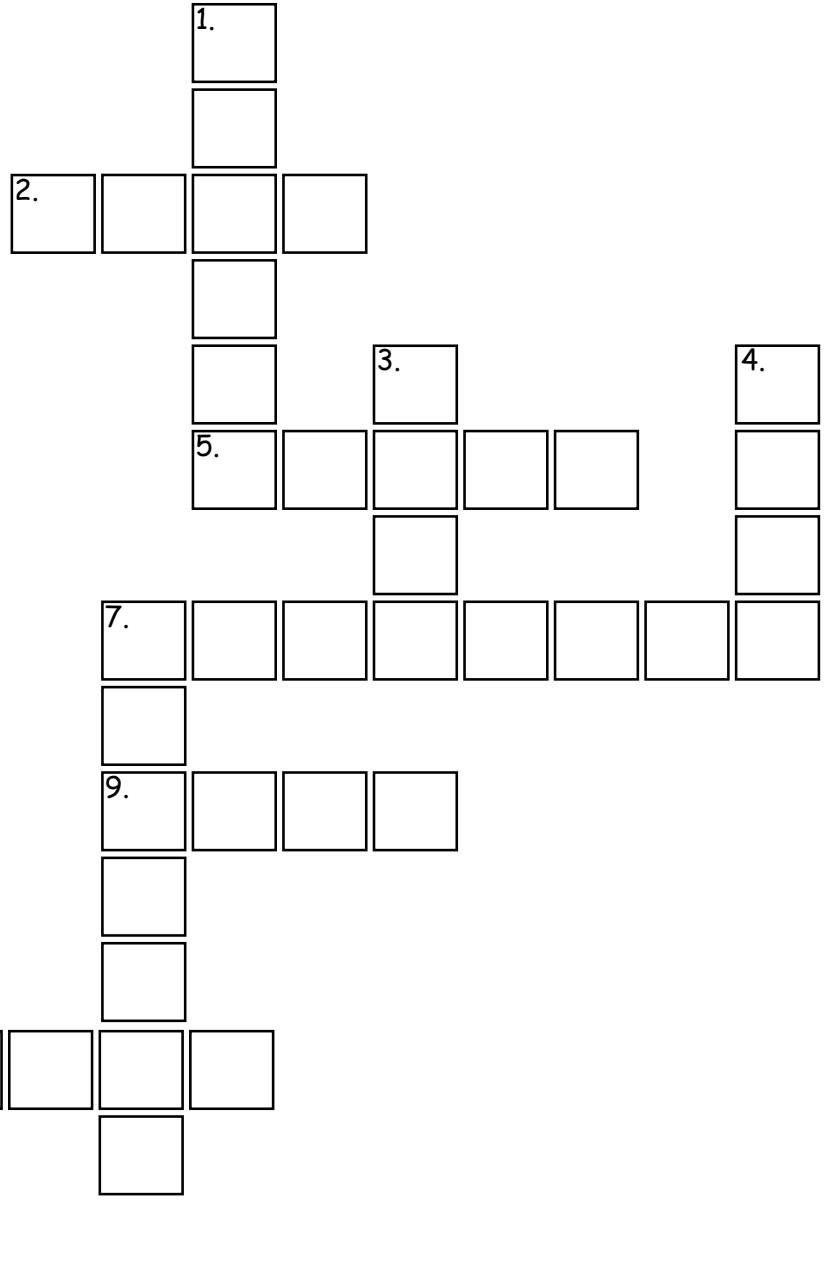

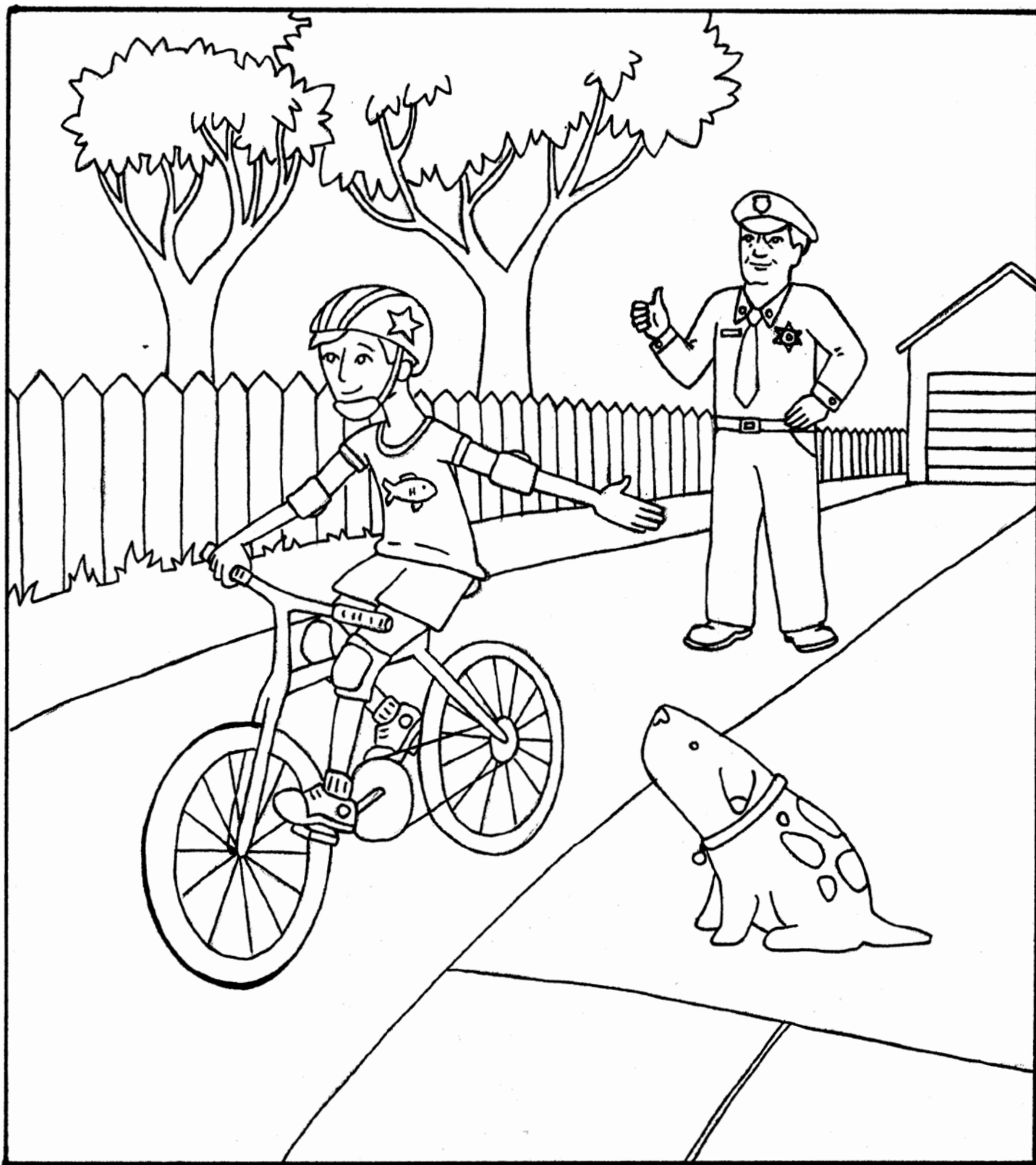

Don't swerve in and out of traffic

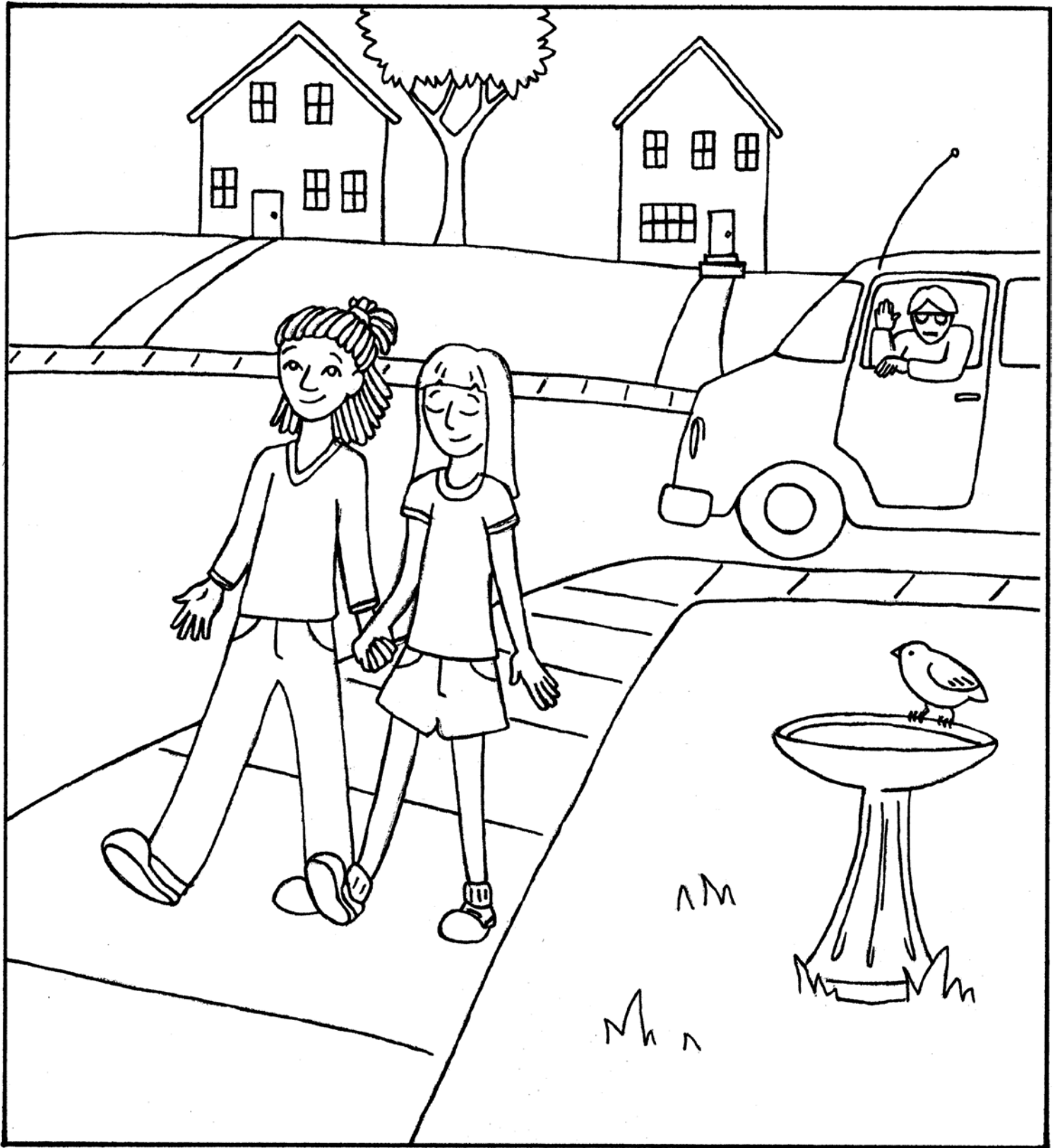
