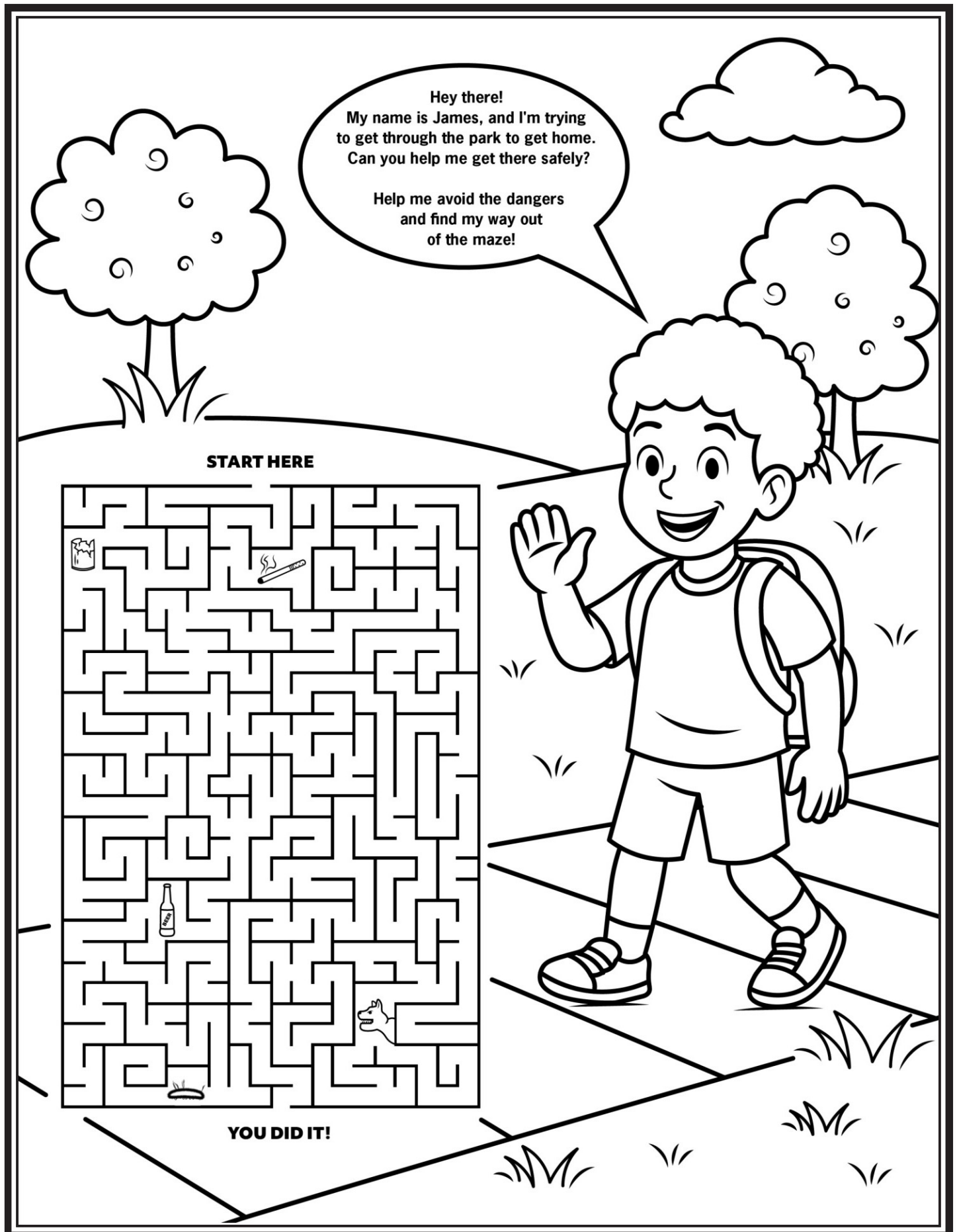


# NEVER ACCEPT THINGS FROM STRANGERS

tell a trusted adult.



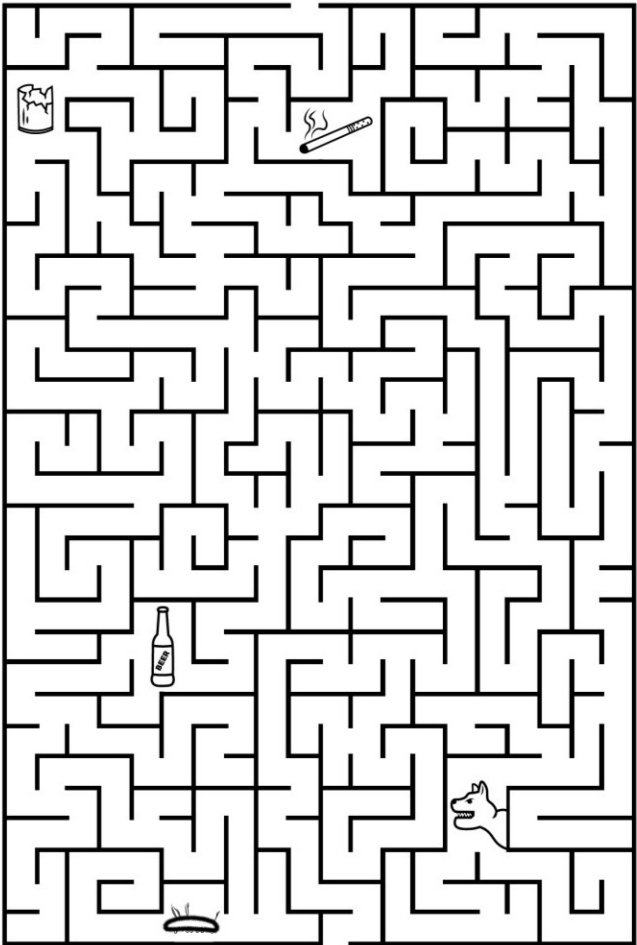

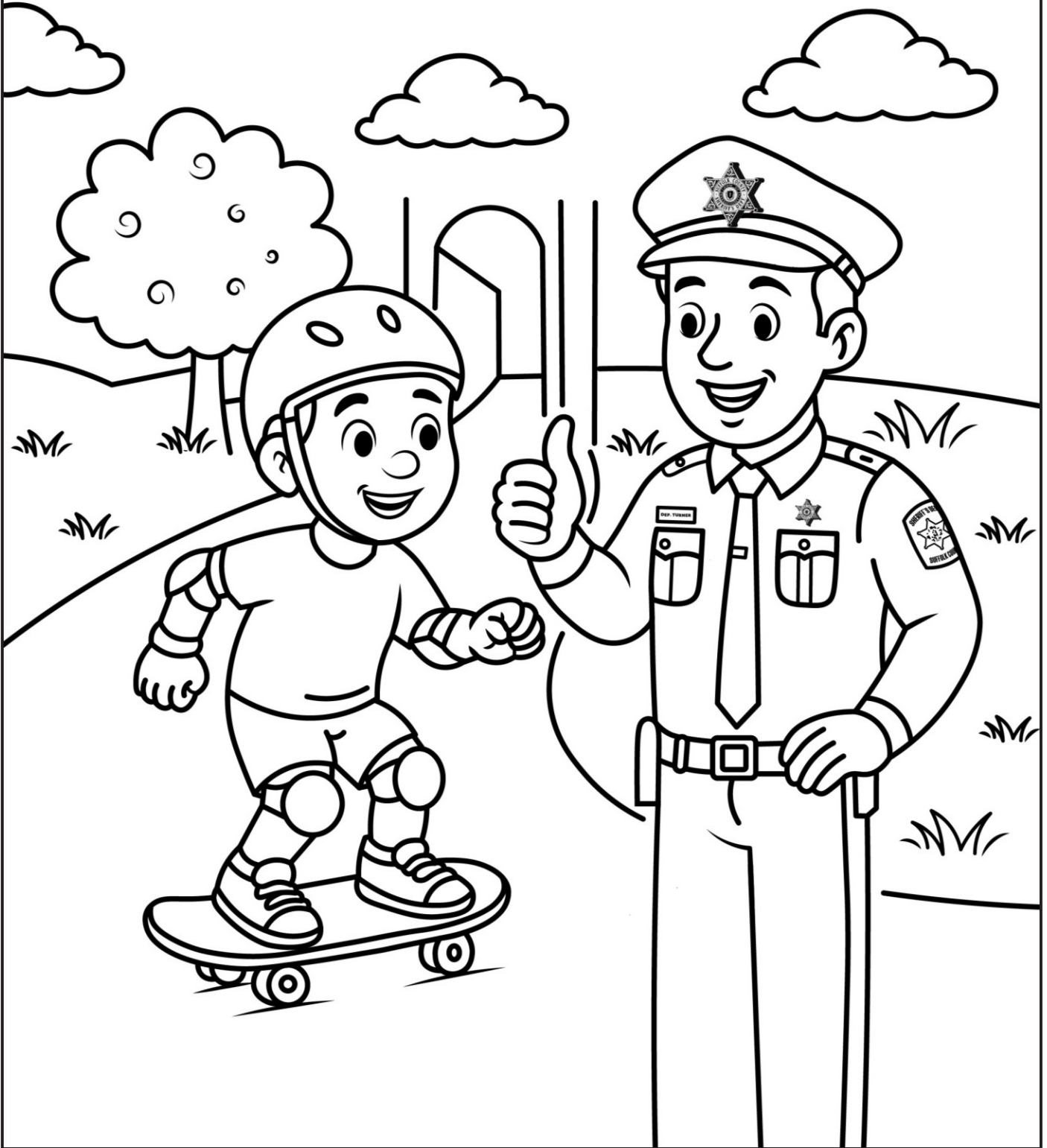
# ALWAYS WALK OUT WITH A FRIEND

**Help K-9 Sasha find the contraband bag and color it red so Deputy Turner can spot it!**





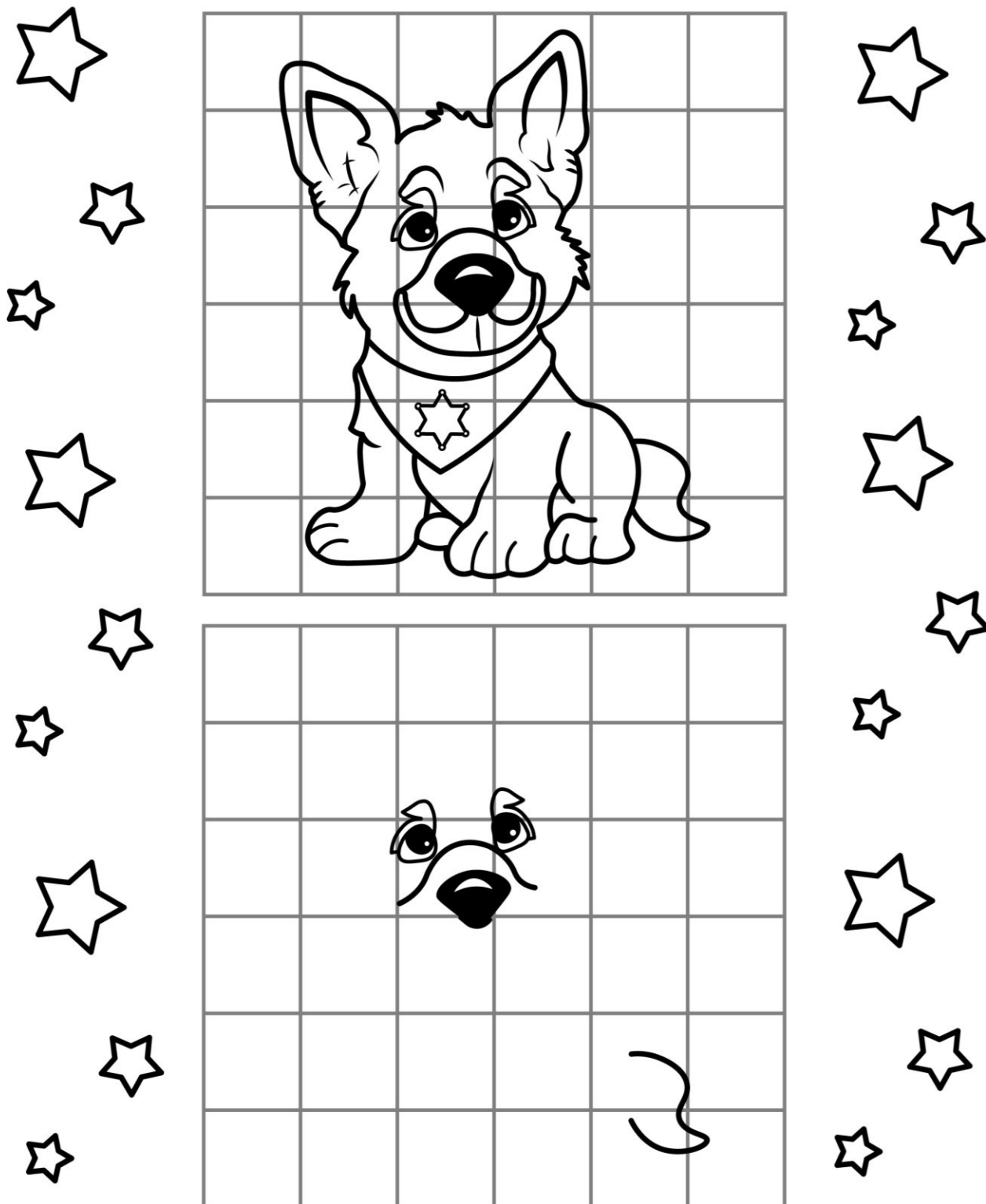
# ALWAYS REACH OUT FOR SUPPORT

and neighborhoods a better place.**



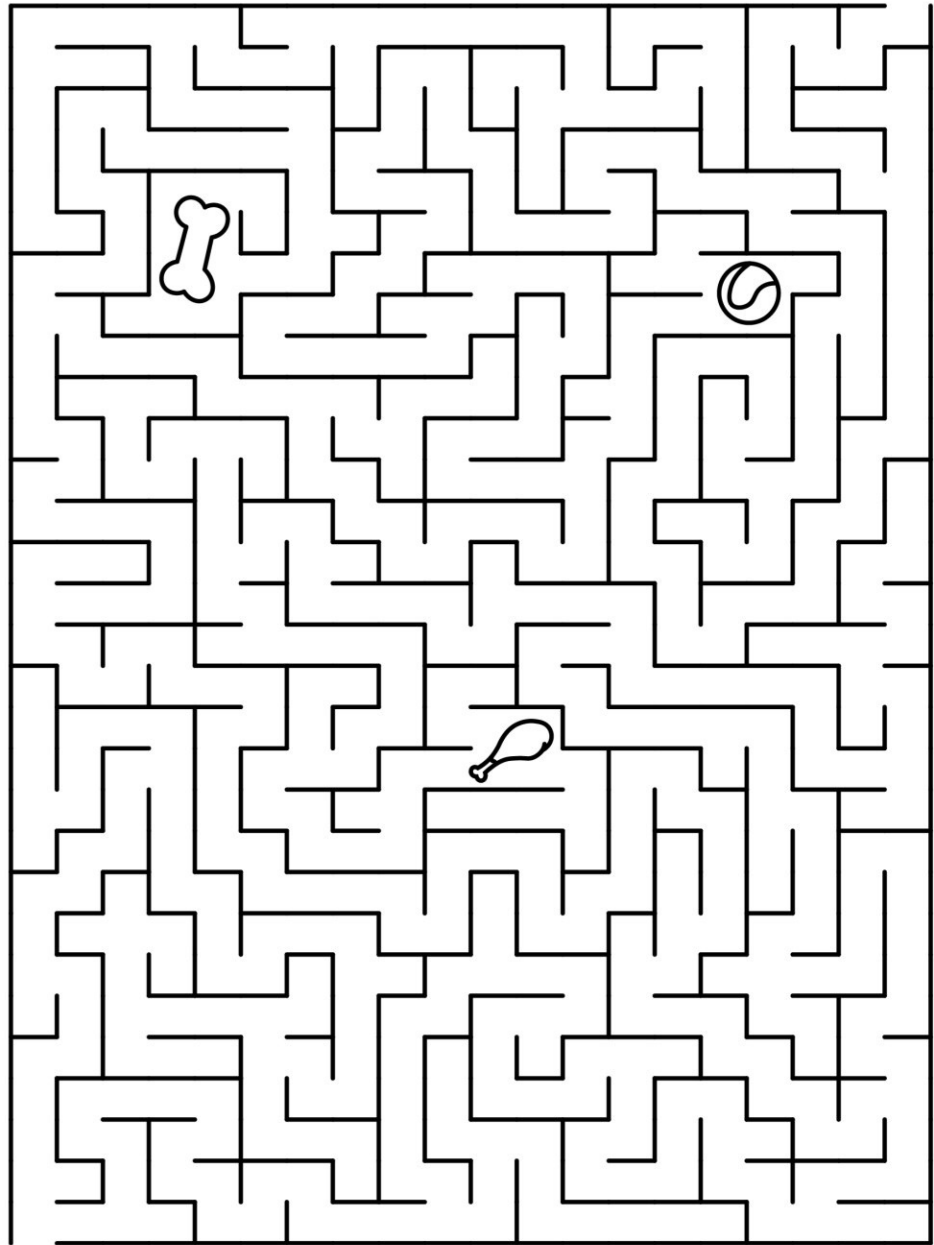

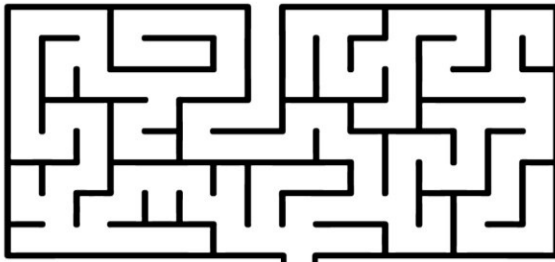

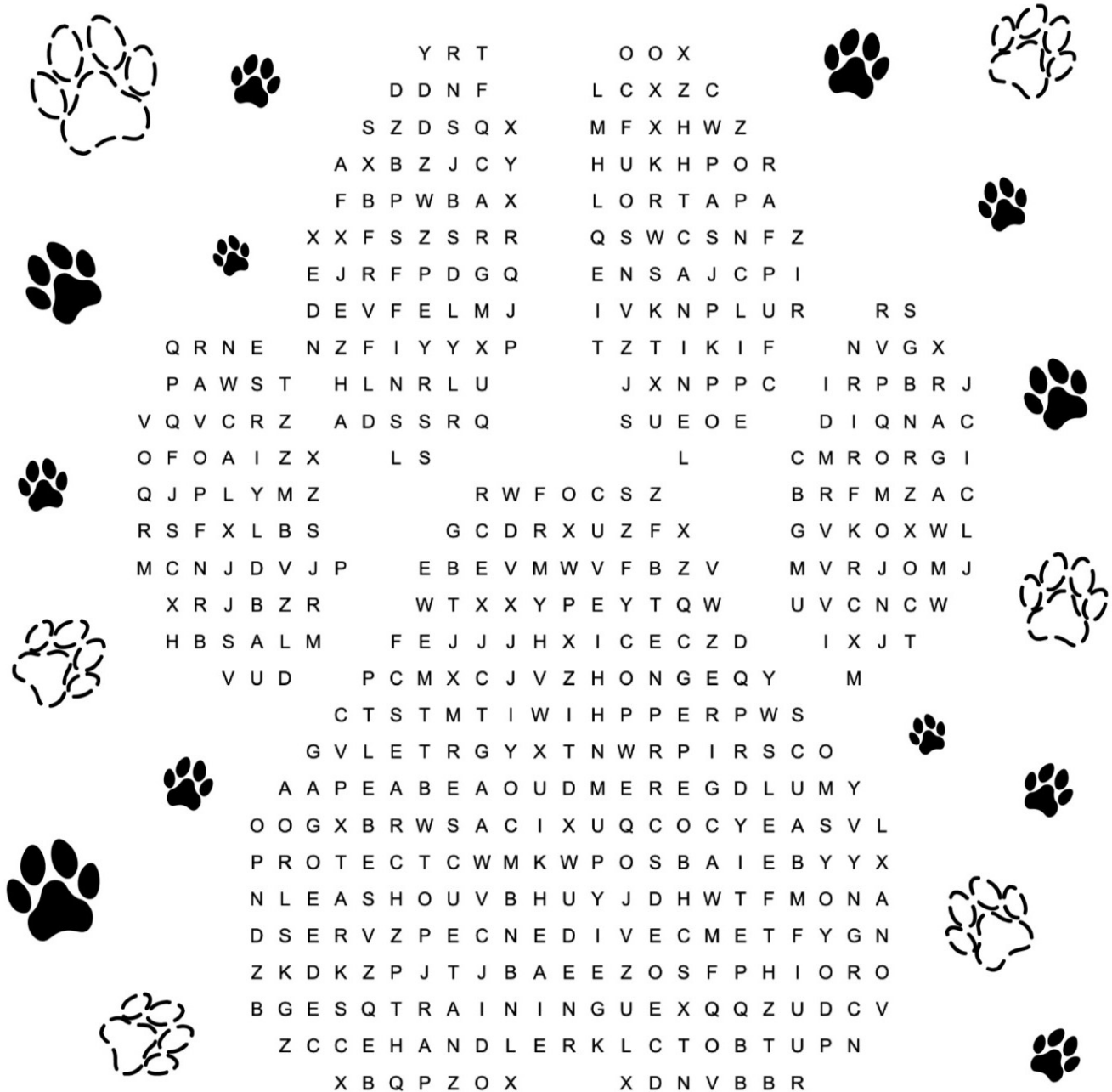

- ☒ Do not go anywhere with the stranger.
- ☒ Find your friends and stick together.
- ☒ Locate a police officer, teacher or trusted adult and tell them what happened.
